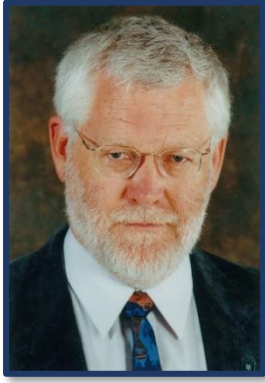

- Abstracts must be limited to 350 words max.
- A minimum 2cm margin should be applied to the entire page.
- Use Arial font size 12 throughout the abstract.
- All of the abstract should be fully justified.
- Leave a blank line between each section if sections are used (Title, Authors, Contact details, Abstract, References (if applicable)).
- Abstract to be accompanied by a one(1) page curriculum vitae (CV) of the presenting author
- Oral presentations will be allocated 20 minutes plus 10 minutes for discussion.
- Please ensure that the email addresses as submitted are correct as these addresses will be used in all correspondence and acceptance notifications.
- Poster Size: A0 - 841mm(w) x 1189mm(h)

- 14 December 2019 - Decision of scientific programme committee to be announced.
- 30 December 2019 - Early registration and payment deadline.

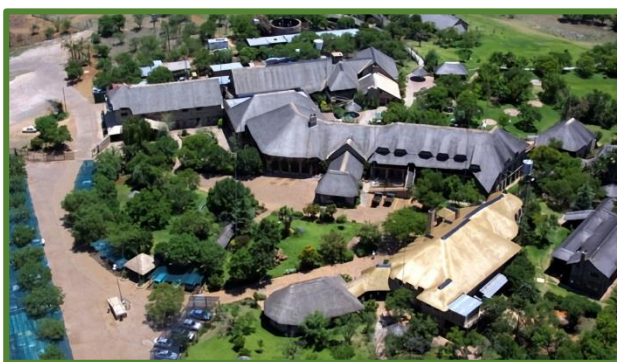
