

- Cancellations received by 30 June 2025 will receive a full refund, less a 10% handling fee on the full value committed.
- Cancellations received between 1 July 2025 and 31 August 2025 will receive a 50% refund on the full value committed.
- Cancellations received after 1 September 2025 will be liable for the full value committed.
- Refunds will be issued after the conference has taken place.
